Linfield community,

I sincerely hope this finds you well.

We expect the Governor to issue a new executive order shortly. In anticipation of that order and in accordance with guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, Linfield is taking the following actions:

- We will extend online-only teaching and learning through the end of the academic year. The
 Governor's order is expected to prohibit in-person university classes through at least April
 28. To provide greater certainty for our community, however, we're making the difficult
 decision today about the entire semester.
- All students will continue to have the option to stay in the residence halls and eat in the dining hall, if they choose.
- The Governor's order allows in-person instruction related to completion of a health-care related certificate or degree.
- We will make a decision by April 10 about whether to hold Commencement and the nursing pinning ceremony.
- Updates and information surrounding refunds or credits for room and board will be communicated through Residence Life.
- Our executive officers are taking a close look at jobs and functions to decide what missioncritical positions require employees to perform their duties on-campus, and which tasks can be done from home.

I want to thank everyone for the calm and thoughtful deliberation that has characterized Linfield during this difficult time. This is a time of deep challenges, and the Linfield community's resilient and determined character is shining through brightly. We will continue to live up to our mission of learning, life, and community.
