## Semester Abroad Program



NÜRTINGEN CAMPUS, GERMANY

Spend a semester or year in Germany, a landmark of economic, political, and social innovations. Nürtingen-Geislingen University (HFWU) has two campuses as the name suggests: one in Nürtingen and the other in Geislingen, about 40 minutes apart from each other. The campus will be chosen for the student depending on the area of study or major of the participant. Both campuses are in close proximity to Stuttgart, Tübingen, and Ulm. Stuttgart, the capital of the German state, Baden-Württemberg, is one of the most economically advanced regions of Germany. Tübingen is known for its university and academic research programs. Ulm has a similar reputation to Tübingen, but is also known for its cathedrals, the famous gothic "Müster," and is the birthplace of Albert Einstein. At HFWU, field trips are included in the program fee.



## Selection Criteria

The program is open to sophomores, juniors and seniors in good academic and social standing. A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 at the time of application is required to participate. While there is no language requirement for this program, students are encouraged to take German courses prior to departure and during the program, to take maximum advantage of varying opportunities offered.

## Housing

Students live in campus dorms during their study in Germany and do their own cooking.

## Dates

Fall semester runs from approximately Sept. - January; spring semester goes from early-March until the end of July. Year long students would begin classes in late-September and return at the end of July.

## Curriculum

Students are required to take 30 ECTS credits per semester. These credits do not correlate to hours spent in the classroom and thus vary by course.

The international course catalog lists the ECTS equivalents for each class and can be found on HFWU's website.

## Costs

Students pay regular Linfield tuition, technology fee and a program fee. Housing is paid directly to the overseas institution. Linfield pays the round-trip airfare from PDX for qualified students' first study abroad experience. Students pay their own passport and visa fees.

## Transportation

A semester fee is applied to students' HFWU accounts for a special public transport ticket which allows students to travel for free in the greater Stuttgart area.

### **BEST: Business Europe Study Tour**
