

## TRANSFER GUIDE 2011 - 2012

### *Mt. Hood Community College*

**Working** and going to school? Transfer to Linfield College and finish a bachelor's degree. Linfield will accept 108 quarter credits of community college coursework with grades of C or better. This equals 72 semester credits of the 125 you need for graduation.

**Majors** in Accounting, Management, Marketing, Nursing (for RNs) and Social and Behavioral Science can be completed online. Additional majors are Arts & Humanities, Business Information Systems and International Business. Almost all requirements for these majors can be completed online. Face-to-face classes are held on the Linfield campuses in Portland and McMinnville and occasionally in other locations.

If you complete either an Associate of Arts Oregon Transfer (**AAOT**) or an Associate of Science Oregon Transfer in Business (**ASOTB**) Degree, you will need to take no more than two additional courses to complete the Linfield Curriculum (general education) requirements.
