Linfield student parking is free. No sticker is needed. Park on evenings and weekends in:

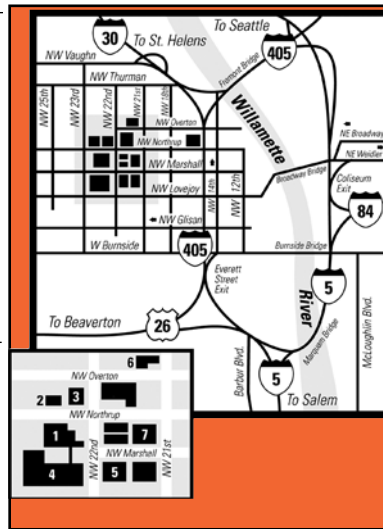
