<p>1. To meet BSN graduation requirements, 30 semester credits must be from Linfield if you are earning your first bachelor's degree. If you are pursuing your second bachelor's degree, you must earn 35 credits at Linfield.</p> <p>2. NURS 416 and NURS 419 include clinical components (84 clinical hours in NURS 416, and 168 clinical hours in NURS 419). Clinical experiences are tailor-made for each RN student, in a setting of their choice. Clinicals generally can be conducted within your work organization, with a department other than the department in which you work.</p>
