ONLINE LEARNING AT LINFIELD

- Courses offered over the web are perfect for students with lots of motivation but little spare time in the evenings.
- All web classes will require you to post assignments by a certain time each week. You can do most of the work on your own schedule.
- Students will have separate links for submitting homework, group discussion, and personal communication with the instructor.
- Tests are mostly done online with an immediate response of your grade (depending on the teacher and class).
- If you have a laptop and an internet connection, you can work while you travel.
