Scott Brosius
Head Baseball Coach
Linfield College

Scott Brosius was a natural choice to succeed retiring coach Scott Carnahan, having served under Carnahan on the baseball coaching staff for five seasons.

Brosius left Linfield following his junior year after being selected by Oakland in the 20th round of the 1987 amateur draft. He returned to Linfield and completed a bachelor's degree in business in 2002.

In three seasons at Linfield, he hit .332 with 14 home runs and 77 runs batted in. During his junior season in 1987, he hit .348 and set Linfield single-season records for most at-bats, hits and RBI. He received recognition on the NAIA all-Area, all-District and all-Northwest Conference teams, and was an honorable mention NAIA All-American.

Brosius spent a total of 11 seasons in the major leagues with Oakland and New York. He won three World Series titles with the Yankees in 1998, 1999 and 2000. Brosius was a Golden Glove award recipient, was named the Most Valuable Player of the 1998 World Series, and played in the 1998 All-Star Game.

Instructors:

Head Coach Scott Brosius will be conducting the all-skills camp with his assistants Scott Carnahan, Jim Ray, Jarvis Gomes, Dave Cunningham, Matt Saltmarsh, and current players.

History:

Linfield has a history of success. In the last 25 years Linfield has finished first in the Northwest Conference 12 times. Most recently in 2008 Linfield made it to the Division III College World Series finishing 5th in the nation.

Instructional Program:

Linfield College Baseball All-Skills Camp is designed to provide exceptional instruction on all aspects of the game. The emphasis of the camp will be dedicated to teaching techniques in hitting, fielding, and pitching.

Each camper will receive personalized instruction and camp T-shirt.

Facilities:

Linfield College is proud of its facilities. The transformation of Linfield's baseball facility began in the late 1980s. Roy Helser Field, together with Jim Wright Stadium, has developed from a below-average facility to a jewel among northwest small colleges. The most recent project, completed in 2008, involved covering the infield with a FieldTurf. Drainage was improved and construction of covered, enclosed batting cages on the venue site was undertaken.

What to bring:

Campers need to bring batting gloves, bat, mitt, and cleats.

Who:

The camp is designed for grades 2 through 12. Because space is limited, the camp is open to the first 50 campers per session who sign up.

Cost: \$150.00 per player.
