Catalog Policy and Instructions

From Portland to the McMinnville Campus:

A student wishing to transfer from the Portland Campus to the McMinnville campus must:

- 1. Complete the Linfield College Intercampus Transfer application. (linfield.edu/assets/files/admission/Apply/intercampustransfer.pdf).
- 2. Submit transcripts from all other colleges and universities attended.
- 3. Submit an essay as part of the application. (Essay topics and requirements are available from the McMinnville admission office.)
- 4. Meet the priority deadline of April 15 for fall semester transfer and December 1 for spring semester transfer.

Any student wishing to transfer into programs with special requirements for admission (e.g. Athletic Training) are not guaranteed acceptance as an intercampus transfer. Consultation with the admission office at the appropriate campus, academic advising, and with a faculty member from the major department is strongly recommended prior to completing the application for intercampus transfer.

From Online and Continuing Education (OCE) to McMinnville Campus:

A student wishing to transfer from the OCE program to the McMinnville campus must:

- 1. Complete the Linfield College Intercampus Transfer application. (linfield.edu/assets/files/admission/Apply/intercampustransfer.pdf).
- 2. Meet the priority deadline of April 1 for fall semester transfer and November 1 for spring semester transfer.
- 3. Submit transcripts from all other colleges and universities attended.
- 4. Submit an essay as part of the application. (Essay topics and requirements are available from the McMinnville admission offices.)

To be considered an intercampus transfer to the McMinnville Campus, students must be enrolled with satisfactory academic progress as a Linfield OCE student for at least one semester and with twelve (12) Linfield credits completed.

Students wishing to transfer into programs with special requirements for admission (e.g. Athletic Training) are not guaranteed acceptance as an intercampus transfer. Consultation with both the admission office at the McMinnville campus and with a faculty member from the major department is strongly recommended prior to completing the application for intercampus transfer.

From McMinnville or Online and Continuing Education (OCE) to the Portland Campus:

A student wishing to transfer from the McMinnville Campus or Online and Continuing Education program to the pre-licensure nursing program (Portland Campus) must:

- 1. Complete the Linfield College Intercampus Nursing application by January 2 for the summer (accelerated) or fall cohorts, or August 1 for the spring cohort. (linfield.edu/portland/admission/nursing-application)
- 2. Meet all requirements listed in the nursing pre-licensure section of the course catalog by the dates posted on the nursing application calendar (linfield.edu/Portland/admission/application-calendar).
- 3. Complete a minimum 30 credits as a Linfield McMinnville Campus/OCE student with satisfactory academic progress.
- 4. Consultation with Academic Advising is strongly recommended prior to application.
