

Routine environmental cleaning plan at a glance

Based on CDC guidelines in preparation for possible community transmission of COVID-19:

Linfield Cleaning Services – McMinnville Campus

- Cleaning Services personnel are currently using spray bottles of disinfectant to clean frequently touched objects and surfaces (e.g., door handles, light switches, countertops, glass) throughout daily work assignments (*21 full-time Cleaning Services employees; approx. 1M square feet*).
- Wall-mounted hand sanitizer dispensers are located in each Residence Hall Restroom and near the hallway entry to each Residence Hall Restroom and Academic Building Restroom.
- Cleaning Services personnel are currently working to label, fill and distribute spray bottles of disinfectant and paper towels so that commonly used surfaces (e.g., keyboards, desks, remote controls) can be wiped down by students, staff and faculty:
 - Classrooms
 - Residence Hall kitchens
 - Common areas – computer labs, Library, etc.
 - Academic Department administration
 - Building/Floor common areas – Melrose Student Central kitchen, Riley 208, etc.

Dillin Hall & Starbucks – McMinnville Campus

- Dining Services personnel at Dillin Hall and Starbucks are currently using spray bottles of disinfectant to clean frequently touched objects and surfaces (e.g., door handles, light switches, countertops, glass) every two hours beginning at 8am.
- Two new hand sanitizer dispensers have been added @ Dillin Hall – one at the registers and one at the main building entrance. There are already dispensers at both of the restroom entrances and at the west building entrance.

Linfield Cleaning Services – Portland Campus

- Cleaning Services personnel are currently using spray bottles of disinfectant to clean frequently touched objects and surfaces (e.g., door handles, light switches, countertops, glass) throughout daily work assignments (*2 full-time Cleaning Services employees; approx. 50,000 square feet*).
- Wall-mounted hand sanitizer dispensers are located at each elevator entrance from the basement up to the 9th floor.
- Cleaning Services personnel have distributed spray bottles of disinfectant and paper towels so that commonly used surfaces (e.g., keyboards, desks, remote controls) can be wiped down by students, staff and faculty:
 - Loveridge Hall:
 - Basement commuter lounge on shelf
 - 1st floor kitchen on paper towel dispenser
 - 2nd floor Rose City conference room by the window
 - 3rd floor HSSR/23 conference room by the window
 - 4th floor employee kitchen on microwave
 - 5th floor residential kitchen

- 6th floor residential kitchen
- 7th floor residential kitchen
- 8th floor residential kitchen
- 9th floor residential kitchen
- Linfield Library
- Peterson Hall:
 - 1st floor room 101A by sink
 - 3rd floor on shelf next to water cooler
