**Additional Requirements for an Oregon teaching license:**

- No grade lower than C in major coursework and licensure coursework
- Minimum 2.75 GPA in major coursework, licensure coursework, and cumulative coursework
- Ongoing recommendation from Linfield College Education Department
- Adherence to the Linfield College Education Department Professional Characteristics & Professional Conduct Expectations
- Admission into the Teacher Education Program
- Passing scores on licensure exams
- Successful completion of part-time and full-time student teaching
