



Meeting Program Requirements: In Progress

The evaluation system has two different uses of "in progress." When in blue parenthesis next to a requirement it means that the requirement is only partially complete. Such is the case of the student in this example. They have completed 0.67 credits but still need 2.00 credits to fulfill the requirement.

A: Paracurriculum (In progress)

Complete at least 2.67 semester credits in paracurricular courses. TOTAL CREDITS: A maximum of 8 credits may be counted toward graduation with no more than 4 courses from any one department.




Meeting Program Requirements: Pending Completion of Unfinished Activity
